A ZEBRA CROSSING HERE ?

The Council has started an **informal** consultation on whether there should be a zebra crossing on Countess Avenue by Warwick Avenue. There's a deadline - Friday 19 June.

If the informal consultation supports a zebra crossing the Council will then carry out a formal (statutory) consultation later this year. This is a legal requirement before work can begin.
