We've been discussing with the Council & SERCO the frequency of missed collections from flats

We usually find out about these from facebook after the problem's been going on for a few weeks. We pass them on to the Council who then look at their records & find they've never been reported.

We think what's happening is that sometimes - within a block of flats - everyone assumes that someone else has reported it.
