TRAFFIC ISSUES ON SAKURA WALK

We wanted to follow up the message in your replies to our Priorities survey last month, Your top two issues were **speeding** in Sakura Walk and **parking** on the pavements.

Here's some background information:

On speeding, there was an estate meeting last June where residents were really worried about the excessive speed of both cars and delivery vans but sceptical that speed restriction signs would help. Installing speed bumps was thought a better solution. But on Brooklands, which we also represent and where there are some speed bumps, residents don't like them because of the damage to cars & vibration in houses. Would road narrowing (chicanes) be a better solution especially along the straight stretch from the junction with Lovat Fields / Camphill up to the first bend? Or from the junction with Gyosei Gardens up to the flats at the top?

On parking, outside London, it's not illegal to park on the pavement. But if you do you can be charged by the Police if you are causing an obstruction. Their test for this is whether a wheelchair or a double child's buggy can get past without having to go onto the road. And they're so thinly spread there's not very much enforcement.
