THE PAVILIONS - STILL NO FINAL DATE



The Parish Council have decided in principle to take over Broughton Pavilion subject to completion of a satisfactory contract with Milton Keynes Council. But negotiations are going slowly (not the fault of the Parish) and even after agreement has been reached it will still take some time for the Parish to move in.

Milton Keynes Council are in discussions with a potential provider for the Brooklands Pavilion. They told us they hoped to make an announcement about this before the end of June, but now they say mid-August. But even so - as with Broughton - it will then take time to set up the new arrangements.
