### TRAVELLERS ON OAKGROVE

The travellers arrived on Friday afternoon, with around 27 caravans.

Because they were on private (school) land the procedures that Milton Keynes Council, the Parish Council and the Parks Trust operate together didn't apply.

But the Police are empowered to act where they believe that it is "reasonable and proportionate so to do given the impact of the unauthorised community on the local settled community." They served notice on the travellers to depart by 11 am on Monday and then - when this hadn't happened - moved in that afternoon to enforce their Order. Four vehicles and three caravans were seized and two arrests made.

There have been some suggestions that the Police might have acted faster. But this wasn't a situation where a couple of constables could have enforced the Order. Officers had to be drawn in from outside the area, specialist equipment hired, and a plan of action agreed in case there was violence.

Longer term Kerrie Bradburn believes we need to take preventive measures to stop this happening again. There's a school on Walnut Tree, she says, which has driven two metre poles into the ground with only the top half metre showing. And they're only a metre apart. So nothing can get in between them. And they're dug in so deep that they can't be knocked aside.
