

Work to remove the trees on the Willen side of the V11 Tongwell Street will start, possibly in December but more likely January, and must be finished by end-February when the nesting season starts. Meanwhile there are ongoing discussions about how many trees must actually be removed.

Chillery Leys residents have won an undertaking that a visual barrier will be provided to protect their privacy during the works.

Looking ahead Berkeley St James have confirmed that they have pencilled in **Wednesday 22 March** next year for the permanent closure of Carleton Gate. However this remains a provisional date pending approval of their overall project schedule.
