Report Here:

We've been getting quite a few messages from residents about pockets of antisocial behaviour on Brooklands. These reports include nosiey mopeds, school students trespassing, litter and loitering outside shops or noise disturbances. We want to reiterate that the best course of action is to report these incidents to the police via the non-emergency 111 service (either by phone or online). The police use the data from reports to distribute resources. If reports aren't logged the police don't know about the issues. We'll also be working with them to ensure they are taking resident concerns seriously.
