

MK East Latest

Technology called MOVA was introduced on the Northfield roundabout to allow the phasing of the traffic lights to reflect the amount of traffic at any particular time. Teams are now starting work at 7 am on the A509 and continuing up to 5 pm on Saturdays whereas previously they had stopped at 1 pm.

The procurement for the new Phase 2 of the MK East contract (dualling the V11 Tongwell Street and the bridge) hasn't yet started. This means that it is "highly unlikely" (I quote the project director) that anything will happen there this year, the only thing that might start is some level of vegetation clearance.

There have been some issues with letters not being circulated across Willen which the developers have apologised for. To stay up-to-date with what's happening with the development and associated road works the best thing to do is download an app which updates with all the relevant info.
