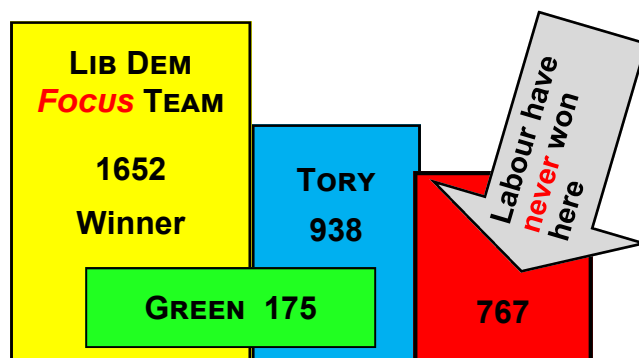

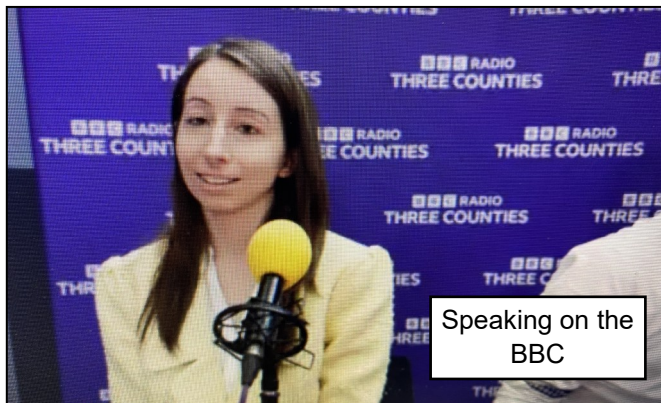

MESSAGE FROM KERRIE

Dear Residents,

I'm writing to let you know that I have made the very difficult decision to resign as your councillor.

As many of you know, my father, Cllr. Robin Bradburn, passed away suddenly in mid-September. His loss has been overwhelming for my family and me.

I had every intention of continuing to represent Broughton Ward (*which encompasses Broughton, Broughton Gate, Brooklands, Middleton and MK Village, Oakgrove, Willen and Willen Park*) for the foreseeable future (subject to elections), but life has a way of changing our paths when we least expect it.

After much reflection, I've decided to stand and fight for my dad's seat in Bradwell, where I grew up. This is not a decision I've taken lightly, but I know it's the right one for me, my mum (who is currently Mayor of Milton Keynes and also a councillor in Bradwell), and my family.

It has been an absolute honour to represent the biggest ward in Milton Keynes, and I will deeply miss working with all of you. The ward will always hold a special place in my heart.

I leave you in very capable hands with Sam & Uroy who will update you with details of the by-election when it's announced.

Thank you all for trusting me to be your voice. I'll never forget it.
