

The Council's draft budget for 2025 – 26 has been published. A 5% council tax increase is proposed together with £20 million of spending cuts due to inadequate government support for local councils. The final decision will be taken in February. Meanwhile there's more here:

The invasive plants have been removed and it's hoped that in the spring it'll be possible to carry out surveys to see what wildlife is taking advantage of the newly restored pond.



POSSIBLE WARD BOUNDARY CHANGES

Every 12 years or so an independent national body - the Local Government Boundary Commission - reviews the size of the electoral wards in Milton Keynes to make sure they're roughly the same size. They've just published their latest draft proposals - here:

Our area is affected because we're so big. The proposal is that we keep Broughton, Broughton Gate & Brooklands but lose Willen, our part of Willen Park, Oakgrove & Middleton. If this is agreed it will take effect in 2026.
