BPHA will soon begin work on 33 new affordable flats in the area.

However, the planned community sports centre next to them is still expected to be "several years away."



Northfield roundabout isn't getting any better. Recent repair work doesn't seem to have had any impact.

The A509 from Newport Pagnell will reopen by the end of August, and the promised upgrade has been postponed until most likely October. We're pressing the Council to realise how serious this now is.
